The goals of the Cultural Trust Fund are to assist qualified organizations in providing cultural, civic, and educational programs, encourage individual and corporate involvement through gifts and bequests, and to administer and invest funds for the creation of perpetual opportunities and services.

- Grants from the Cultural Trust will be used for programming and operations

Grant applications will be reviewed on the following criteria:

- Benefit to and number of residents in Jefferson County who will be affected
- Past grants to your organization
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The applications are reviewed by the Grant Committee during August and recommendations are made to the Board of Directors. Action will be taken at a full Board of Director's meeting to distribute the available funds. All grant applicants will be notified as to their approval or denial. Checks for the amount granted are usually distributed in August.

NOTE: Recipients will be required to complete and sign a Grant Agreement before any grant funds will be disbursed.
